Note: Kates v. 2 includes which sons fought in the War of 1812 and that when Celea melted down the silver teapot, it was so that she would have bullets to take with him. In v. 1 he says "... in a celebrated military-naval action at the mouth of Canadawake where their rude, log house was situated. Their next home, a frame structure, is still standing as a one-story wing attached to a more recently constructed two-story house on the property of the Holy Cross Apostolic Center on Route #5 west of Dunkirk. When we get that far, the deeds should prove interesting... IF deeds were even filed... and with that much property, there probably was a family burial ground out there? Too bad that not even Holy Cross is still standing now. It was razed to build luxury homes on the lake... next to the Fredonia sewage treatment plant... and remains vacant land. The Google mapping was done when the trees were bare but I can't see much. Any cemetery probably eroded into Lake Erie years ago, anyway. Something interesting to think about, however.

During the war of 1812, Celea Sampson Cole saw a number of boats crossing Lake Erie; apparently British soldiers. She rode to Fredonia, sounding the alarm.

Celea Sampson was the first child of Joseph Sampson Samson and Sarah Hall. She had seven siblings, namely: Daniel, Sylvanus, Me Isaac, Isaiah, Kenelm, Sarah, and Abel. She died Nov 18, 1840 [not] in Fredonia, Chautauqua, New York, USA. She married Seth Cole, son of Ebenezer Cole and Ruth Churchill, Sep 15, 1780 in Chesterfield, Hampshire, Massachusetts, USA.

Celea Sampson was baptized Aug 12, 1764 in Duxbury Parish, Plymouth, Massachusetts, USA. She lived in Chautauqua, New York, USA in 1840.

es claims to have had a copy of her will, dated 14 December 1832, Dunkirk, Chautauqua, New York, United States. Nothing was found in Mayville, NY, but we did find a will for Erastus which named his five daughters and their husbands [see below].

Sylvenus is not in the online War of 1812 militia records but then, WNY was the wild and woolly west at that time, barely settled. We are more likely to find an obituary reference to a specific battle, e.g., the burning of Buffalo, than formal military service. There was an organized attempt in the 1900s to get veterans tombstones for War of 1812 soldiers and these are distinct, when found.

Erastus T. Foote was Chautauqua County's first historian. He persuaded the early (Chautauqua County was part of Niagara Co in 1810 census, effective 1811) Board of Supervisors to stop burning the official minutes to warm the meeting room and went on to collect our earliest records. Later historians used his *Papers* as the basis for their books.
