Another feat of senior ability and energy took place on December 16, 1967, the senior party under the theme of Mistletoe Magic. An enjoyable time was had by all who attended.




# Valedictorian




# Winter Ball-'68

Thankful for all the invaluable help given by our class advisor Mr. Colicchia, the Sophomore Class now looks on to the upcoming years at D.H.S.




As we look back on our freshman year, we find it was a year of great joy in which many new friends, ideas, and experiences were gained.




