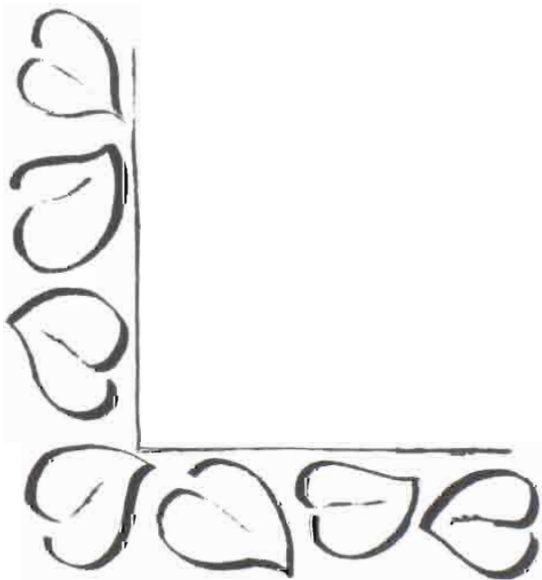




FOREWORD

Thanksgiving evening the club honored the football players at its annual football dance. A dance in honor of the basketball team was held on March 4.

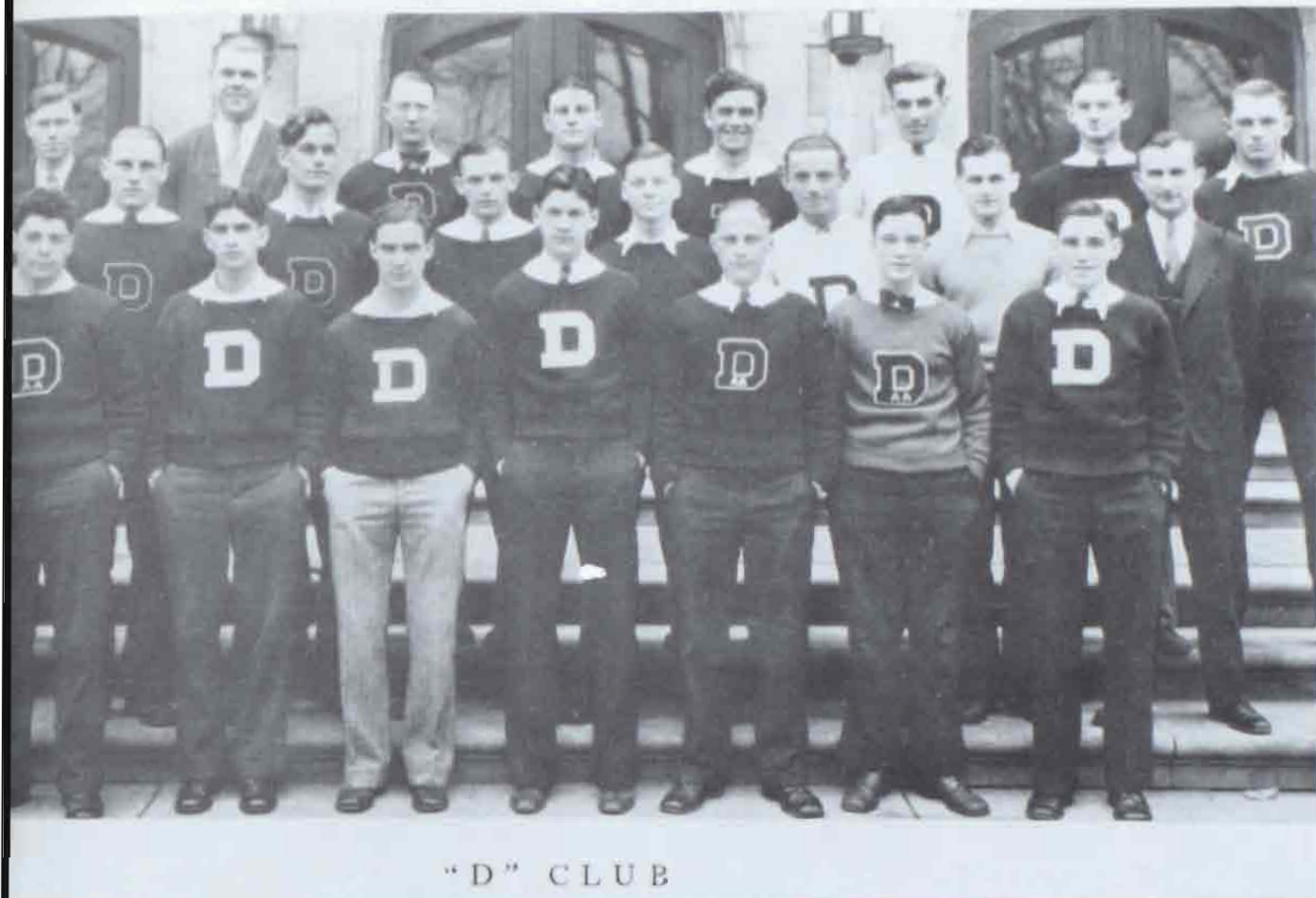
