Mary Scaglione was re-elected President our Junior year, with Thom Andrews, vice-president, Fran Catalano, secretary and Kevin Ricotta, treasurer. Our advisors, Mr. Catrona and Miss DeAngelo, helped us to a second place homecoming float based on the theme "Keep on Truckin." Sue Green was our Homecoming Queen. Her escort was Steve Gittings. # Carol Leone—Our "Special" Superlative



After the balloting for senior superlatives had been completed, the IVY TOWER staff decided that "superlative" applies to one of their classmates in a special way. This classmate is Carol Leone.

On November 2, Carol was named the high school winner of the statewide piano competition sponsored by the New York State Music Teachers Association. In addition, Carol was selected as the accompanist for the 1974 All-State Choir and won a place in that choir as a soprano. Significantly, she had no time to rest after this accomplishment. She was due on the stage of Fredonia High School for the Dunkirk-Fredonia Junior Miss Pageant where she captured the scholastic award, the talent award, and a place as second runner-up.

Behind Carol's triumphs are years of hard work and dedication to a goal. She began her music studies when she was only three and a half years old, and she performed in her first recital at the age of four. As if excellence as a pianist was not enough, Carol has thirteen years of ballet and jazz dance study with Eloise Heyl of Dunkirk, about eight years experience in trap set drumming, and is an oboeist with the DHS band. Her classmates will always remember Carol's performances in "West Side Story", "The Wizard of Oz," and, especially, "Fiddler on the Roof."

She was a member of the Marauder Cheerleading squad her first three years at DHS and is an enthusiastic participant in a wide range of other activities for her school. In her "spare time," Carol teaches piano.

# THE CRUCIBLE





# THE MIRACLE WORKER








The Keller family was portrayed by Jim Ebert and Pam Berstein as Mr. & Mrs. Keller, Steve Gittings as Helen's step-brother.


The DHS Wrestling Team, in only its fourth year of existence completed its season 8-7 against Division I League Squads.
